

**Q. No. 29: Who are not eligible for Stray Vacancy Round of AIQ/Deemed/ Central Universities/ AIIMS/JIPMER?**

Ans. Following categories of Candidates are **not eligible** for Stray Vacancy Round:-

- a) Candidates who have not registered for Stray Vacancy Round.
- b) Candidate joined/holding any seat at the time of Stray Vacancy Round.
- c) Candidates allotted a seat in Round 3 of MCC and NOT REPORTED.

All candidates not falling under above-mentioned categories are eligible.

**Q. No. 30: Will there be any Fresh Registration/choice filling for Stray Vacancy Round?**

Ans. Yes, there will be Fresh Registration/choice filling for Stray vacancy Round.

As per the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India vide **order dated 12.12.2022** passed *I.A NO. 132614/2022 IN W.P (c) NO. 267/2017 in Dar-us Slam Educational trust and Ors. vs. Medical Council of India & Ors.*,”

the Medical Counseling Committee (MCC) of DGHS, MoHFW, shall conduct the online counseling for the Stray Vacancy Round of 100% seats of Deemed Universities.

**Q. No. 31: How much time will I be given to join the allotted college?**

Ans: Candidates allotted seats will be required to join the allotted college/course within stipulated time which is mentioned in counseling schedule. However, candidates are advised to join as early as possible and not to wait for last day of joining, due to different schedule of holiday (including local holidays) / working hours in various Medical / Dental Colleges. In some of the colleges/ universities, 2-3 days' time is required to complete admission formalities. Therefore, candidates are advised to contact allotted college immediately after declaration of result of counseling allotment process, to know the details. If candidate fails to join the allotted Medical/Dental College within stipulated time, then the allotted seat will be cancelled.

**Note: Under no circumstances, the date of joining can be extended by the MCC.**

**Q. No. 32: What documents are required at the time of Joining/ Reporting in allotted Medical/ Dental/Nursing College?**

**Ans:** Original documents (along with attested photocopies of documents) for admission to under- graduate medical/dental/nursing courses for admission to allotted college are required at the time of joining in allotted Medical / Dental College are as mentioned below.

- I. Allotment Letter issued by MCC
- II. Admit Cards of Exam issued by NTA.
- III. Result/ Rank letter issued by NTA.
- IV. Date of Birth Certificate (if Metric Certificate does not bear the same)
- V. Class 10th Certificate
- VI. Class 10+2 Certificate
- VII. Class 10+2 Marks Sheet
- VIII. Eight (8) Passport size photograph same as affixed on the application form.
- IX. Proof of identity (Aadhar/ PAN/ Driving Licence/ Passport)
- X. For NRI candidates following documents are mandatory:
  - a) Passport copy of sponsorer, embassy certificate
  - b) Sponsorship affidavit (stating that sponsorer is ready to bear the expenses for the whole duration of study)
  - c) Relationship Affidavit (Relation of Candidate with the sponsorer)
- XI. For OCI/PIO/Foreign national candidates citizenship certificate/ card number documents are mandatory,
- XII. The Candidate should also bring the following certificate, if applicable:
  - (a) SC/ST Certificate issued by the competent authority (in the standard format as specified in the prospectus/information bulletin) and it should be in English or Hindi in language. Sub caste should be clearly mentioned in the certificate. Some of the States insist for English version of Caste Certificate. In case the certificate is in regional language the candidate should carry an Attested translated copy of the certificate in English/ Hindi.
  - (b) OBC-NCL as per Central List certificate issued by the competent authority. The sub- caste should tally with the Central List of OBC. The OBC candidates should not belong to Creamy Layer to claim OBC reservation benefit. The OBC certificate must be in the standard format as mentioned in the prospectus/ Information Bulletin.
  - (c) Disability Certificate issued from a duly constituted and authorized Medical Board in an online format by the designated centres as per NMC norms (Gazette Notification no. MCI-34(41)/2018-Med./170045 dated 04/02/2019). No other PWD certificate, issued by any other Authority/Hospital will be entertained.
  - (d) EWS Certificate as per the prescribed format.

Candidates are advised to see college information, of allotted college for, any other document which may be required by the allotted college.

The Candidates who have been allotted a seat through NEET UG Counseling by MCC are

informed that they need to upload the scanned copies of original documents to the MCC portal as per the dates mentioned in the schedule published by MCC.

***Candidates without original certificates/documents shall not be allowed to take admission in allotted Medical/ Dental College.***

**Q. No. 33: In case I have Birth Certificate / Caste Certificate/ other certificate(s) in regional language, will it be acceptable at the time of reporting?**

Ans: Certificates issued by the competent authority on standard format, should be in English or Hindi language. Please remember that some of the states insist for certificate in English language only. Candidates are advised to carry certified (attested) Copy of English version of the original certificate, in case certificate issued is in other than English language, along with original certificate.

**Q. No. 34: If there is discrepancy in spelling of name in documents and application form, what do I do?**

Ans: If there is discrepancy in spelling of name in documents, candidate must carry proof that the documents belong to same person, in the form of an affidavit.

**Q. No. 35: What if I do not have my Original Documents with me at the time of joining the allotted college?**

Ans: The Candidates who have been allotted a seat through NEET UG Counselling by MCC are informed that their admission is provisional subject to physical verification of documents by the allotted college authorities. The MCC has no role to play in physical verification of documents. The candidates need to have their original certificates at the time of reporting.

Candidates who have deposited their original documents with any other Institute/ College/University and come for admission with a certificate stating that "their original certificates are deposited with the Institute / College / University" will not be allowed to take admission in allotted Medical/Dental College.

**Q. No. 36: Will NRI/OCI/PIO/Foreign national Candidate be shown seats reserved for Jain Minority/Muslim Minority?**

Ans: No. As per the policy of MoHFW any Candidate who is NRI/OCI/PIO/Foreign National will not be shown seats reserved for Jain Minority/Muslim Minority. One Candidate can only opt for one type of reservation.
